RIDE OUT CALENDAR FOR 2011

Kevin Dewane had attended a two day Road Captains course at HOG Headquarters and explained some of the principles.

We are required by HOG to have a Guest policy and it was agreed that guest riders could ride with us 2 times to 'test the water' and decide if they would like to ride with us, all riders must be full HOG members. As we are a HOG chapter and representing Harley-Davidson only Harley-Davidson motorcycles would be allowed on ride-outs. Both these points were to be added to the chapter bylaws.

Another HOG stipulation raised was that Road Captains should always carry incident forms on all chapter rides out, Andy has these in the HOG manual and on CD.

The ride out calendar was walked through and the Road Captains agreed who would support each ride out.
